DUTIES: Under close supervision of the Project Manager or Unit supervisor, within the Division of State Police, as part of a team environment develops web-based intranet and internet applications for the Division and the NJ law enforcement community utilizing Java, Oracle and VB.NET 4.5 and SQL Server; supports legacy java applications; supports other project teams to assist in the development of new applications for the Division as instructed; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of programming, systems programming or computer analysis experience.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year for year basis with thirty (30) semester credit hours being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: A Master's degree in an information technology field will substitute for the required experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: SharePoint and Microsoft Business Intelligence development experience is preferred.
