NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the general direction of the Executive Director, New Jersey Racing Commission the official is responsible for the enforcement of rules and regulations governing horse racing contests and events; officiates and oversees pre- and post-race proceedings and the judging of racing contests; authorizes and conducts investigations; suspends and/or fines individuals for cited infractions of rules and regulations; does other related work as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in the horse racing industry, two (2) years of which shall have included experience as an official presiding over horse racing related activities, one (1) year of which shall have included experience involving pari-mutuel wagering operations and activities.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a valid license issued by the Racing Officials Accreditation Program (ROAP) to officiate at flat racing and/or harness horse races.

Appointee may be required to possess membership in the Association of Racing Commissioners International (ARCI).

Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

PREFERNCE: Preference will be given to applicants who possess a valid license from the United States Trotting Association to officiate harness horse races and accreditation by the Racing Officials Accreditation Program (ROAP).

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
