Notice of Availability and Award of Funds

FFY 2018 Federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), Non-Competitive Confidential Sexual Violence Advocate Program

Take notice that in compliance with the Federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) of 1984, 34 U.S.C. §§ 20101, et seq., the Department of Law and Public Safety (Department) announces the availability and award of the following non-competitive subawards funded by FFY18 VOCA program funds:

Confidential Sexual Violence Advocate Program \$6,090,000 Total (\$145,000 per agency for two years)

Under this program, \$6,090,000 in grant funding will be offered to the twenty-one (21) county-based lead sexual violence service programs to support the provision of Confidential Sexual Violence Advocate services throughout each respective county.

The Department will award funds to lead Sexual Assault agencies as designated by the Division on Women. Prior to the awards, each agency will submit an application for review and approval.

New Jersey Coalition Against Sexual Assault (NJCASA) (Lawrenceville) \$200,000

Under this program, \$200,000 in VOCA Administrative funding will be offered and awarded to New Jersey Coalition Against Sexual Assault in Lawrenceville for the purpose of providing training and other support to other NJ CASA agencies that are part of this program.

Funding is provided on a reimbursement basis only and is contingent upon subrecipient application submission, compliance with grant conditions, and satisfactory performance of services. The funding is for a 24-month period from July 1, 2019, June 30, 2021.

Please note that funding allocations and individual subaward amounts are subject to change.

Subrecipients shall recognize and agree that both the initial provision of funding and the continuation of such funding under a grant agreement is expressly dependent upon the availability of the Department of funds appropriated by the State or Federal Legislature from State and/or Federal revenue to such other funding sources as may be applicable. A failure of the Department to make any payment under a grant agreement or to observe and perform any condition on its part to be performed under a grant agreement as a result of the failure of the State or Federal Legislature to appropriate funds shall not in any manner constitute a breach of a grant agreement by the Department or an event of default under a grant agreement because of the absence of available funding appropriations. In addition, future funding shall not be anticipated from the Department beyond the duration of the award period set forth in a grant agreement and

in no event shall a grant agreement be construed as a commitment by the Department to expend funds beyond the termination date set forth in a grant agreement.

Eligible applicants will receive application packages from the Office of the Attorney General, Grants Development Section. Applicants must complete and submit the application with all applicable documents and signatures no later than August 1, 2019.
